GOALS

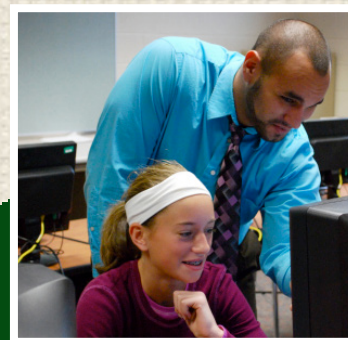
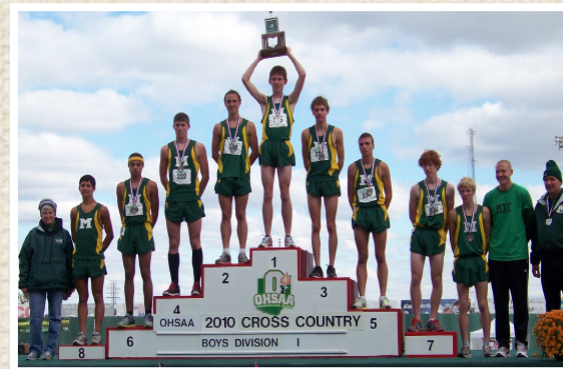
- ▶ Restructure and expand the curriculum to further develop an integrated learning model that reflects the needs of the ever-changing job market.
